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Breaking Ungodly Relationship Bonds

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When a person develops a close relationship with another individual, a bond can seemingly form between their souls and/or spirits. If this occurs between godly believers in a healthy manner, as it did with David and Jonathan, the results can be very positive (1 Sam. 18:1).

Creating such a bond with an ungodly person can be dangerous, however. God specifically warns us not to establish bonded relationships with unbelievers, as the darkness in them is not compatible with the righteousness within the believer, who is the temple of God (2 Cor. 6:14-17). As this passage suggests, the soul connection formed in such a relationship seemingly provides a portal through which any entities of Satan in the unbeliever can extend their influence into the believer's life as well.

If believers have themselves become spiritually contaminated through specific sins or free will bonds they have made with darkness, this same fluidity of spiritual darkness can also occur through any relationship bonds they establish with other believers, especially if the bond is unhealthy or ungodly in any way. While Paul's admonition to refrain from association with immoral Christians is often perceived to have a disciplinary purpose, we can't rule out the possible concern for this deeper danger that it opens to the believer (1 Cor. 5:11).

Engaging in any kind of illicit sexual union with another person outside of one's marriage always produces an ungodly relationship bond through which darkness can flow between the two people involved, whether there is a true soul connection or not (1 Cor. 6:15-16). Codependent relationships in which an individual enables or supports the other person in an unhealthy lifestyle, feels indispensably needed by the other, or gets unhealthy personal needs met through the other person also open this door. Counselors must be very cautious of not establishing this kind of ungodly relationship bond with their clients. All individuals must be careful never to take the role that belongs to God in another person's life.

Ungodly relationship bonds can also be established with people who have had any authority over you in a way that has caused a fearful subjecting of yourself to them. Since the angelic sons of God are so similar to mankind that they can procreate with each other, I believe that it may be possible to form ungodly relationship bonds with fallen sons of God who have taken authority over a person in any way as well. When ritual sacrifices are made in order to have a particular effect on a person, an ungodly relationship bond can actually form between the sacrificed life and the person. The same applies to familial spirits who serve in any kind of supervising role over a person.

Either person in an ungodly relationship can disengage from the bond. Withdrawing from all ungodly aspects of the relationship will be necessary to keep the ungodly bonds severed.

To do this for yourself, you can pray:

1. Most High God, I acknowledge that my relationship to _____ is/was not healthy or pleasing to You.

If you were guilty of sin, add: I confess my sin in _____ (having sex with this person or taking responsibility that was Yours, etc.).

2. I ask You to sever all ungodly relationship bonds between me and _____ (you can list more than one person here, if appropriate) and all with whom they were in ungodly relationship bonds.
3. I ask You to remove from me all evil spiritual, ungodly, and familial entities as well as all powers, forces, energies, lights, life forces, winds, mists, or anything else of an ungodly nature that gained access to me through these ungodly bonds.
4. I also ask You to remove from me any part of their souls, spirits, or life forces that intermingled with mine and to return to me, cleansed by the blood of Jesus Christ, any part of my soul, spirit, or life force that intermingled with theirs.
5. When these exchanges are complete, I ask You to sever the spiritual conduits between us, close them, and seal them with the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Thank you, Most High God.

To lead someone else in breaking these bonds, you can do the following:

1. Ask the person:
 - a. Do you desire to break all ungodly relationship bonds with _____? (You may list more than one person or entity at a time.)
 - b. Do you recognize, confess, and repent of all sin that you committed in the relationship(s)?
2. Pray:
 - a. Most High God, in light of what _____ has confessed with his/her mouth, I ask that You sever the ungodly relationship bonds between _____ and _____ and all with whom they were in ungodly relationship bonds.
 - b. I ask You to remove from _____ all evil spiritual, ungodly, and familial entities as well as all powers, forces, energies lights, life forces, winds, mists, or anything else of an ungodly nature that gained access to him/her through these ungodly bonds.
 - c. I also ask You to remove from _____ any part of the other entities' soul, spirit, or life force that intermingled with his/hers and to return to him/her, cleansed by the blood of Jesus Christ, any part of his/her soul, spirit, or life force that intermingled with theirs.
 - d. When these exchanges are complete, I ask You to sever the spiritual conduits between them, close them, and seal them with the blood of the Lord Jesus Christ.
